For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2023-24. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2023-24. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

North Central Academy continues to build upon an academic foundation for students in effort to increase academic performance. Staff has focused on building academic routines in the classroom as well as implementing research-based curriculum for targeted Tier 2 support in effort to increase learning and close academic gaps. We believe that it is our responsibility to not only build an atmosphere of learning based on strong curriculum and classroom practices, but also to help students transfer these skills into real world situations beyond high school. Therefore, in addition to the "Don't Wish for It, Work for It" initiative that was started the previous year which focuses on building a post-secondary plan with students that involve either military, trade, or college paths we have implemented a College and Career Readiness class for senior high school students in effort to

create targeted experiences and resources for post-secondary goals. Additionally, North Central Academy worked to acquire a Great Start to Readiness Preschool program for the 2024-2025 school year in effort to create a strong foundation in literacy, math, and social skills which will lead into the K-12 program.

- 1. PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL North Central Academy is a tuition-free public school academy serving primarily the Mancelona and Gaylord areas. North Central Academy enrollment is open to all Michigan residents.

  MICIP school improvement plan throughout the year. The Committee is made
  up of a variety of staff members, community members and parents. Staff
  meets monthly to discuss our student improvement plan and make sure we
  are implementing the plan in our school. We continually conduct stakeholder
  surveys, discuss goals and objectives, analyze data, and evaluate growth
  based on our student improvement plan.

  In addition to core instruction, North Central Academy offers instruction in
  Musical Theatre, Art, Classroom Music, Physical Education, Character
  Education and Finance. We also offer two co-op athletics programs.

Overall, parent/teacher conferences have a strong success rate with an average of 79% attendance rate for elementary classes. Secondary classes had a 46% attendance rate.
